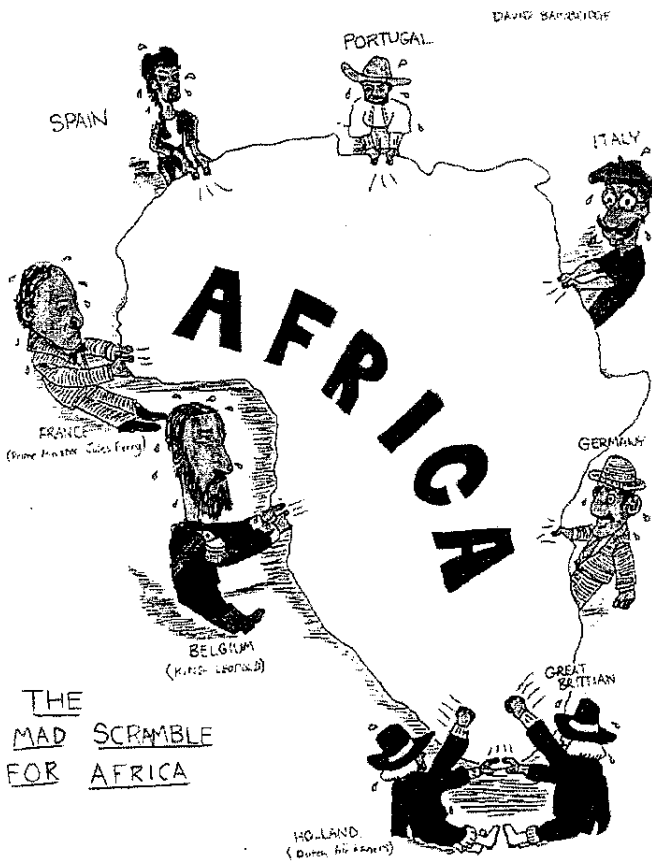


4. How does this relate to the White Man's Burden?
